





Ammonia producers



- Large ammonia producers that own an annual ammonia production capacity that is equal to/exceeds 1Mt/y
- Small ammonia producers that own an annual ammonia production capacity that is equal to/exceeds 50,000 tons but does not exceed 0,5Mt/y

- Companies involved in energy storage via ammonia
